Your pet is scheduled for anesthesia/surgery. We recommend a blood profile to ensure that your pet is in a low risk category prior to anesthesia. The latest technology has enabled us to run safe and accurate blood chemistries before anesthetic induction. These tests are similar to those your own physician would run were you to undergo anesthesia. In addition, the results of these tests will serve as reference values for future use should your pet become ill.

PROFILE #1 **Healthy patients under 2 years of age**
CBC/BUN/ALT/TOTAL PROTEIN
(Assesses anemia, infection, clotting problem, kidney/liver disease, dehydration)

PROFILE #2 **Patients 2-7 years of age**
CBC/CHEM 6 (ALT, ALKP, BUN, CREA, GLU, TP)
(Assesses anemia, infection, clotting problem, kidney/liver disease, dehydration, glucose)

PROFILE #3 **Patients over 7 years of age**
CBC, CHEM 12 (ALB, ALT, ALKP, AMYL, BUN, CALCIUM, CHOL, CREA, GLU, PHOS, TBIL, TP, ELECTROLYTES, URINALYSIS)
(Assesses anemia, infection, clotting problem, kidney/liver disease, dehydration, glucose, urinary tract infection, cholesterol, pancreatic disease)

PAIN MANAGEMENT

Research has indicated that while pets may appear to withstand pain better than humans, they still experience it to a great degree. While undergoing surgery, your pet will receive anesthetic drugs that prevent pain. However, additional medications have recently become available that enable us to safely and effectively control the level of your pet's discomfort after surgery and during their recovery at home. Since we care about your pet's comfort, we recommend a pain management medication.

LASER

Laser energy seals nerve endings as it moves through the tissue. Your pet feels less pain post-operatively. The laser also seals small blood vessels during surgery which allows the doctor to perform surgeries with extraordinary precision. This also speeds some procedures reducing the need for extended anesthesia. Laser technology reduces the trauma to your pet, improves recovery, and often shortens hospital stays.

QUICK-BACK NAIL TRIM

A nail trim in which we cut into the nails' blood supply and thus trim the nails back very, very short, decreasing the frequency in which your pet will need his/her nails trimmed. Because your pet is under anesthesia, he/she feels no pain.

HOME AGAIN™ MICROCHIP

Identification chip placed under the skin.
